

## Resolution Supporting the Legalization of On-site Power Purchase Agreements for Renewable Energy Facilities in West Virginia

The City of Bluefield supports cost-effective investments in renewable and efficient energy Whereas, technologies; and Whereas, On-site Power Purchase Agreements would allow municipalities and other tax-exempt entities to acquire renewable energy cost effectively; and Whereas, On-site Power Purchase Agreements are currently available in at least 28 states, including Maryland, Ohio, Pennsylvania and Virginia; and Whereas, On-site Power Purchase Agreements allow customers to lock in electricity rates and protect against utility rate increases; and Whereas, The US Department of Labor lists solar PV installer as the fastest growing occupation in the nation; and Whereas, On-site Power Purchase Agreements would therefore expand job creation in West Virginia; and Whereas, More than 180 major corporations have made corporate commitments to use 100 % renewable energy; and Whereas, The lack of renewable energy in West Virginia hinders our ability to attract these corporations and the jobs they would bring to our state; and Whereas, Legislation is needed to authorize the use of on-site Power Purchase Agreements for renewable energy facilities in West Virginia; and Legislation authorizing on-site Power Purchase Agreements for renewable energy facilities would help municipalities Whereas,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Board of Directors of the City of Bluefield supports legislation authorizing on-site Power Purchase Agreements for renewable energy facilities in West Virginia; and
